



Code of Conduct Policy – 2025

Having FUN, a POSITIVE ATTITUDE and GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP are the most important things for young skaters.

Expected minimum standards of behaviour and conduct:

As a skater with Empire Roller Skating Club I will:

- Respect my sport
- Be on time and be polite
- Try my hardest and do my best
- Play fairly–I won't cheat
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, with dignity
- Respect club facilities and equipment
- Respect others
- Listen and respond to my coach or any volunteer who is helping me
- Respect the decisions of officials
- Control my emotions–verbal or physical abuse is not acceptable
- Never bully, spread rumours or tell lies (including social media e.g. Facebook)
- Protect other skaters from abuse and bullying
- Welcome new young people
- Make sure I tell my coach/parents if I think another young person needs help
- Have Self Respect
- Take responsibility for my actions
- Never use inappropriate language or gestures
- Tell someone I trust if the behaviour of others makes me feel uncomfortable

By joining Empire Roller Skating Club, you are agreeing to stick to this Code of Conduct and all the club policies, rules, regulations and procedures. If you break the Code of Conduct, your parents will be informed, and your behaviour might be investigated, and disciplinary action might be taken. As a last resort you may be asked to leave the club.
